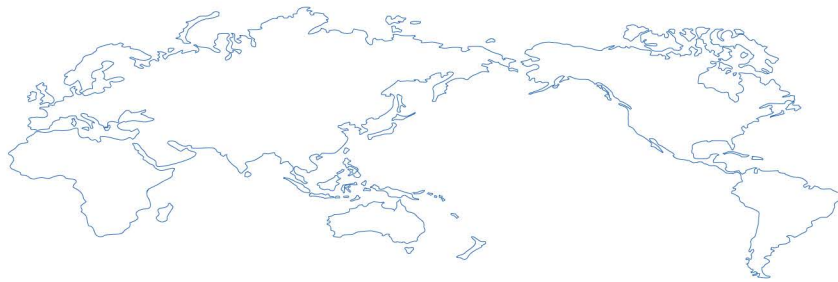
WHAT IS THE DIPLOMA IN NURSING CARE FOR THE ELDERLY?

This is a unique and specially designed programme for nurses, trainee nurses and carers who are responsible for looking after older people.

The course focuses on meeting the needs of the elderly population who have long term and acute conditions, such as dementia or urinary tract infections, or improving preventative care in areas such as pressure ulcers.

This is a comprehensive video based, easy to navigate, online learning programme that will improve the skills of your nurses and carers when caring for the elderly. They can study and complete the course on their phones, tablets or computer, at anytime and anywhere and it can be used as a refresher tool to enhance and update knowledge.

HOW DO I ACHIEVE THE DIPLOMA?

Once you have been accepted onto the programme, there are four modules that you will need to complete in order to achieve the full Diploma in Nursing Care for the Elderly. Each module offers a programme of study which lasts between two and four months and it is expected that the full Diploma will take about 11 months to complete.

The course is delivered online using over 300 short and easy to understand videos, along with activities and assessments. This means that each of the modules can be studied in short, sharp bursts, whenever or wherever it is convenient.

The modules can also be taken individually and on successful completion, a certificate will be awarded.

EXAMPLE QUESTIONS AND ACTIVITIES

What types of questions when I need to answer?

The full Diploma or the individual Certificates can only be awarded by successfully completing online assessments at the end of each of the topic areas. These practical questions will challenge students to apply the lessons they have learnt to practical issues that occur in real life nursing and care circumstances.

All the questions use tick box, drag-and-drop, drop-down list type answers rather than essay questions. This may make it easier for students who may find essay answers difficult, and this approach also allows a much more precise and detailed interrogation of the students' knowledge.

All of the questions can be answered using the information contained within course videos. There will be no need for students to research elsewhere except to extend their knowledge and understanding.



COMPLETING THE COURSE

What do I receive once I complete the Diploma?

Once all four modules have been successfully completed, students will be awarded the Diploma in Nursing Care for the Elderly.

Each year, the students who have completed the Diploma with the highest marks will be invited to Addenbrooke's Hospital in Cambridge for an educational visit and conference. They will also be able to continue to participate in our online events and benefit from our global peer network.

Students who opt to take individual modules will be awarded a Certificate in the modules that they complete.
